**Recommended Action:** Acceptance of a Transportation Cost Apportionment Agreement with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission for construction of intersection improvements at 32<sup>nd</sup> Street and Connecticut Avenue.

**<u>Background</u>**: In August, 2014 Joplin voters passed the renewal of the Capital Improvement Sales Tax for an additional ten years. One of the projects included in the program was City Wide Intersection Improvements.

The Commission will pay for fifty percent (50%) of the total construction cost and any cost to move utilities estimated at \$1,422,172.

**Discussion:** Attached is the proposed agreement between the City of Joplin and Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission. Total estimated cost of project including engineering and construction is estimated at \$1,422,172. MODOT will share in the cost 50% for a total of \$711,086. The City's share consists of \$711,086 but MODOT will reimburse the City for the design cost for an estimated total of \$157,441. The City will then use CIST funds to cover the remainder of the 50% match estimated at \$553,645. The city will be required to remit payment for that amount to cover the estimated project cost no later than 8 weeks prior to the Commission's advertisement of the project for bids. Payment will be due in this fiscal year with bidding occurring in the late fall and construction happening in 2018.

The project will add a north bound right turn lane and an east bound right turn lane improving traffic flow in the intersection.

**Recommendations:** Staff recommends acceptance of this agreement on an emergency basis, per Section 2.12 (6) of the HOME RULE CHARTER of the City of Joplin.
