Recommended Action: Approval of a Work Authorization with Allgeier, Martin & Associates Inc. in the not to exceed amount of \$31,965.00 for engineering design, bidding and construction management services associated with the replacement and rehabilitation of the Grit Augers and Troughs at the Shoal Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility.

Background: Part of the treatment processes at the Shoal Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant are the Grit Augers. They separate the grit from the water and it settles into clarifiers and into troughs. This waste is disposed at landfills. This is one of first procedures during the treatment process. The plant currently has two Grit Augers that have rusted troughs. The life expectancy of this type of equipment is normally 10 years; and must be periodically replaced to ensure proper wastewater treatment and removal of inorganic grit. One Auger was replaced seven years ago, while the trough of the other one was replaced six years ago. Corrosive sewage has deteriorated both of these sooner than anticipated.

Discussion: The firm of Allgeier-Martin & Associates has been selected from the on-call engineering list to provide the professional engineering services needed to accomplish this replacement and maintenance project. The scope of work will include the preparation of design and bidding documents that will provide for the replacement of the Auger Bits and rehabilitation

of the troughs. This work will be funded from the Sanitary Sewer Fund project that was approved in the FY 2017-2018 Budget. This is within Engineering standards.

Recommendation: City staff recommends approval of Work Authorization with Allgeier Martin & Associates Inc. for the not to exceed amount of \$31,965.00 for engineering services associated with Design, Bidding and Construction Management Services for the Grit Augers at the Shoal Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility be approved on an emergency basis per Section 2.12 (6) of the Joplin City Charter.
